Over the years, we have had a number of people ask when we will be accepting credit card for membership, trip and other club payments. Beginning with the November's General meeting, the Battle Creek Ski club will be able to accept Master Card, Visa, American Express and Discover Credit and Debit cards. We will have to pass the handling fee of 2.85% along to the members wishing to use their plastic. This will allow us to keep our prices for the trips and membership at their low pricing. To clarify for those who want to use their plastic: a \$40.00 family membership will have \$1.14 added to cover the handling charges, making the membership payment \$41.14 and a \$500.00 trip payment will have \$14.25 added to cover the handling charges, making the trip payment \$514.25. As always, we are still be accepting checks and cash. We leave the choice up to you, our members.


welcome wine and cheese party and a dinner. The condos are beautiful and all have fireplaces. Come join the fun skiing and group time in the fun village of Breckenridge.

BRECKERIDGE'S PEAK 6 IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Breckenridge Ski Resort's new Peak 6 project will add 400 acres of lift-served terrain serviced by a new high-speed, six-person chairlift and a new fixed-grip chairlif -- plus another 143 acres of hike-to terrain for the 2013-2014 ski season. Peak 6, will give Breckenridge five peaks, acres, four terrain parks, a 22 foot Superpipe, 11 bowls, the highest chairlift in North America.

SKi Like A PRO

Hit the slopes on alpine skis and enjoy dramatic mountain views, invigorating fresh air and the chance to fly down a trail as fast as you dare. Even better, skiing tones your legs and boosts strength and anaerobic capacity.

With advances in both techniques and gear, dare devils and tenuous turns alike can improve their skiing. These tips will help you cruise down with ease.

Relax Your Toes.
Flex Your Ankles.
Keep Your Shins Against the Tongues of Your Boots.
Put Pressure on Your Ski Tips to Start a Turn.
Roll Your Skis From Edge to Edge.
Keep Your Skis Parallel.
Keep Your Hands Forward.
Plant Your Pole Down the Hill.
Stay Centered in Powder (and equally weighted on both skis).
Look Ahead, Not at Your Skis.
