



Who needs a **REAL ID**? Anyone who plans to travel by air within the United States or enter certain federal facilities such as military bases or nuclear power plants will need a REAL ID document beginning Oct. 1, 2021. Find out if you are REAL ID-ready by using the online tool in the link below.

The REAL ID starA standard driver's license or state ID card that's a REAL ID will be marked with a star in the upper right corner. Airport TSA agents will look for that star when REAL ID goes into effect.

All enhanced driver's licenses (EDL) and state ID cards are automatically REAL ID-compliant with or without the star because they already meet the high security standards of the REAL ID Act. Some people have EDLs without the star because they got it before Michigan started issuing REAL IDs in 2017. EDLs without a star will automatically be printed with one the next time they are renewed or replaced. According to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, TSA agents at airports will recognize EDLs as valid REAL ID documents, even without the star.

Welcome to the 31st annual Winter Park Ski Trip. This year we will be leaving from Battle Creek on April 3rd, travel by rail and arrive in Winter Park on Monday April 4th. The train takes us through the heartland of America, and gives us the opportunity to enjoy the scenic beauty, talk and join our friends in card or board games, read a book, or just relax. We will be shuttled to Beaver Village, where the amenities include a club house with three jacuzzis, swimming pool, lockers, sauna, and meeting areas. Beaver Village is within walking distance of Downtown Winter Park. Free shuttles travel to Winter Park Ski Resort, Winter Park and Frazier. The trip includes a four day lift ticket, 5 night lodging in condos that offer complete kitchens, fireplace, and color TV. WP offers a NASTAR race course for those who are interested. We will depart from Winter Park Saturday afternoon, April 9th and enjoy a relaxing train ride home, arriving in Battle Creek Sunday, April 10th.

Trip Cost per Person:

\$915 per person for 2 bedroom / 2 bath condo (Additional pricing available for children ages 2 to 17 and persons wishing to make travel arrangements on their own).

Options:
